## Decorations



**The American Flag may be displayed at all times.**

Flags shall be no larger than 12" x 18" and shall be displayed in grave markers supplied by the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars or other organizations. Please make sure the flags are in displayable condition and secure in their holder.



**Decorations are permitted from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**NO** decorations after October 1st until May 1<sup>st</sup>. Decorations will be removed by the Cemetery Sexton during this time. The exception is those decorations that are in permanent, immovable, concrete pots. Flowers in these pots must be secured in a way that they cannot be dislodged in a strong wind.



**Christmas & New Years:** Decorations will be allowed to be placed on graves the week before Christmas Day, but must be removed by January 8<sup>th</sup>, the week after New Year's Day, or they will be removed by the Cemetery Sexton.

Because the Sexton has the right to refuse any improper monument, Buyers and monument sales persons should contact the Sexton before purchasing monuments. Contact the sexton at the City of Redfield 605-472-0660 or [cityhall@redfield-sd.com](mailto:cityhall@redfield-sd.com) for the exact regulations for your Division.

➤ **Divisions A thru G** (the old sections) are divided into two 10 foot by 20 foot blocks with a 2 foot strip between for monuments. Each 10 foot by 20 foot block is divided into five grave lots each 4 foot wide. There are 8 foot alleys on each end and 3 foot alley on each side of the blocks.

The monument regulations for divisions A thru G are as follows:

1. No large monuments shall be set on the outer ends of graves. Large monuments may be set in the 2 ft. strip at the center of each block. Large monuments are to be set in concrete at least 2 feet in depth with a six inch wash, level with the ground.
2. Markers, not to exceed eighteen (18) inches in height, may be placed at ends of graves just inside the alley-way.
3. All monuments must be in proper alignment and therefore setting of all monuments and markers are to be coordinated with the Sexton.
4. All ledger markers must be set flush with the ground.
5. Recessed flower vases next to markers are permissible.

➤ **Divisions H, I, & J** (the new section) Currently only Division I is open for burials. Graves in this section are in contiguous rows from north to south. There are two rows of 10 foot by 4 foot grave lots in each block and 10 foot alley-ways between the blocks.

The monument regulations for divisions H, I, & J are as follows:

1. **Ground level markers only** are allowed and are to be set at the alley end of the graves. Markers are to be aligned with the edge of the grave with the wash on the alley side. This is to be coordinated with the Sexton.
2. Recessed flower vases next to the markers are permissible.

## **Additional Policy and Regulations**

| <b>1. Perpetual Care</b>                       | Your lot will have perpetual care.  |
| <b>2. Flower Vases</b>                         | Recessed flower vases next to the markers are permissible. Arrangements must be made with the Cemetery Sexton for permanent plant holders.  |
| <b>3. Government &amp; 2nd Markers</b>         | Government markers and second markers are to be placed at the east end of the graves. Markers should not exceed four feet across and should be aligned with adjacent markers.   |
| <b>4. Care</b>                                 | The Sexton will do mowing, grave filling, tree trimming and Grass seeding.  |
| <b>5. Responsibility</b>                       | Neither the City of Redfield, nor the cemetery sexton shall be responsible for lost or damaged decorations.   |
| <b>6. Restrictions Needing Sexton approval</b> | Digging holes anywhere in the cemetery, using insecticides or herbicides within the cemetery, placing anything on or near a grave which will hinder mowing, and planting trees, bushes, or plants anywhere within the cemetery. |
| <b>8. Common courtesies</b>                    | No driving off roadways.<br>The speed limit within the cemetery is 10 mph.<br>No dogs are allowed in the cemetery.  |
